

Instructor Shortage Policy

Although the O.D.T.C. Committee will always endeavour to provide enough Instructors for Sunday Morning Training, this will not always be possible. As members are aware, we are losing our regular Instructors due to age related illness and death. As the general membership has been reluctant to step forward and support their club, the Committee has reluctantly found it necessary to implement the following policy:

Normal Sunday

1 Available Instructor

Action:

The Instructor will combine classes 1 and 2

Class's 3 and 4 will each be asked to nominate a Facilitator* for the day

Classes 3 and 4 members will each be issued an Exercise Card, then proceed to their allotted training rings and commence training

2 Available Instructors

Action:

The Instructors will instruct classes 1 and 2

Classes 3 and 4 will each be asked to nominate a Facilitator* for the day

Classes 3 and 4 members will each be issued an Exercise Card, then proceed to their allotted training rings and commence training

3 Available Instructors

Action:

The Instructors will instruct classes 1,2 and 3

Class 4 will each be asked to nominate a Facilitator* for the day

Class 4 members will each be issued an Exercise Card, then proceed to their allotted training ring and commence training

Beginners Sunday (1st Sunday of each month)

1 Available Instructors

Action:

The Instructor will instruct the beginners only

Two volunteers** will be required from Class 4, to help instruct Classes 1 and 2, and co-ordinate their members to use the Exercise Cards provided. These volunteers will also be required to collect and return the Exercise Cards and the end of training.

Class's 3 and 4 will each be asked to nominate a Facilitator* for the day.

Classes 3 and 4 members will each be issued an Exercise Card, then proceed to their allotted training rings and commence training

2 Available Instructors

Action:

The Instructors will instruct beginners, and Classes 1 and 2 combined. Class's 3 and 4 will each be asked to nominate a Facilitator* for the day. Classes 3 and 4 members will each be issued an Exercise Card, then proceed to their allotted training rings and commence training

3 Available Instructors

Action:

The Instructors will instruct Beginners and Classes 1 and 2. Classes 3 and 4 will each be asked to nominate a Facilitator* for the day. Classes 3 and 4 members will each be issued an Exercise Card, then proceed to their allotted training ring and commence training

4 Available Instructors

Action:

The Instructors will instruct Beginners and Classes 1,2 and 3. Class 4 will each be asked to nominate a Facilitator* for the day. Class 4 members will each be issued an Exercise Card, then proceed to their allotted training ring and commence training

***The Facilitator** will simply co-ordinate members in the use the Exercise Cards provided, although they will still be able to train their dog.

**** The two volunteers** will be required from Class 4 because they may be required to explain the exercise cards and demonstrate training techniques. Training their dogs may not be possible.

The Committee reserve the right to modify the Instructor Shortage Policy, depending on class size numbers on the day

Any member who is unhappy to train in accordance with this policy, and therefore wish to leave the club grounds, are entitled to have their ground fees returned to them
